What's Next – COVID Relief Legislation

- HEROES Act passes House on May 15, 2020
- Senate GOP putting together their own package
- Goal: Final package before August recess (Aug. 10)
- Flash points:
 Payroll tax cut
 Liability protection
 Aid to state and local governments
 Overall size of package (\$1 trillion vs. \$3 trillion)



CARES Act: Charitable Giving

- Temporary Universal Charitable Deduction through 2020
 - Expands charitable deduction to non-itemizers
 - \$300 cap
 - No gifts to donor-advised funds, supporting organizations
- Suspension of AGI limitations for cash gifts through 2020
 - No gifts to donor-advised funds, supporting organizations
- For corporate gifts, 10% limitation increases to 25% for 2020.



Universal Giving Pandemic Response Act (S. 4032, H.R. 7324)

- S. 4032 introduced by Sens. James Lankford (R-OK), Chris Coons (D-DE), Amy Klobuchar (D-MN), Mike Lee (R-UT), Tim Scott (R-SC), and Jeanne Shaheen (D-NH)
- House companion (H.R. 7324) introduced by Reps. Mark Walker (R-NC) and Chris Pappas (D-NH)
- If enacted, it would:
 - Raise the \$300 cap to over \$4,000 for individuals/\$8,000 for couples
 - Extend the availability of the deduction to the 2019 and 2020 tax year
 - Allow all taxpayers (itemizers and non-itemizers) making donations between December 31, 2019 and July 15, 2020 to claim those gifts on their 2019 tax filings
